

My name is Erica and I am a survivor of sexual abuse. I am also a woman who has received healing from the pain of my choice to abort my child.

In full transparency, what I've gone through used to cover me in incredible shame and guilt. But today, I stand with boldness to share the truth. Not because every part of my healing journey is complete. I still have healing to do! But, I know who my God is and that through His Goodness, Grace, and Strength, I am still here. I want to share with other precious ladies who have suffered with similar struggles, that there is hope and actual healing that God alone can give. Thank You Lord!

I was a victim of childhood sexual abuse that, unfortunately, came about in the hands of two adults that were close to me. It happened in two separate timelines, in the span of elementary age to my late teens. Both abusers were members of the church and many people knew what they'd done, yet not much was done to properly protect me. This was very devastating. There were so many consequences to sexual abuse for me: distrust, blind anger, feelings of inadequacy, allowing disrespect and more abuse because I didn't know my worth, contemplations of taking my own life, and so much more. Worst of all, it made me doubt God's love for me and His Presence in my life. I felt hopeless.

The abuse finally ended completely at the age of 19 when I became pregnant with my abuser's baby and chose to abort the child. I didn't know what else to do. I wanted to protect my abuser. I didn't want to be blamed by others. I didn't know what I would tell my child as they grew up about who their father really was. I felt abortion was the only course of action that I could take in which I'd be more protected. After the abortion, the sexual abuse stopped...but, I'd lost my baby.

This broke me.

As an adult, I carried this weight of both the trauma of abuse and pain of abortion. I found that I simply couldn't bury, numb, or ignore it.

In His grace, God rescued me from my burden. He let me know that He sees me. All of me... and still loves me. His LOVE provided a river of healing through new, healthy relationships, therapy, small groups/support groups (such as Abortion Recovery Alabama), and through GRACE Groups. In GRACE Groups, I came to discover that God sees me as His daughter and loves me in spite of. Unconditional, in-spite-of-kind-of-love is a love that freed my broken heart and drew me closer to Him. I entered GRACE Groups fearful of if my heart could bear facing the pain and graduated knowing that I could lay down the sin, shame, and guilt and carry the peace, forgiveness, and support of the Father. **Thank you Lord for freeing me!**
